Australia's Victoria Crosses

Lesson objective

Students will demonstrate their ability to graph and interpret results.

National Curriculum Links

 Math (display a range of dates on a bar graph, interpret a bar graph)

Key Fact

Out of the 100 Victoria Crosses received by Australians, four were awarded to Royal Australian Air Force members. The Royal Australian Navy has not yet received a Victoria Cross, mainly because military action involving ships often means the loss of the entire ship, with few witnesses alive and able to describe the events within a set time period for the Victoria Cross award process to be set in motion.

Extension Activities

Discuss other way to graph the information. As a class create different tables and graphs using the same information and compare.

Task

A bar graph (as called a bar chart) is a graphical display of data using bars of different heights.

Create a bar graph using the following data:

Boer War (1899-1902)	6
World War I (1914-1918)	64
North Russia (1919)	2
World War II (1939-1945)	20
Vietnam (1962-1972)	4
Afghanistan (2001-2013)	4
