European Countries in the First World War

Lesson objective

Students will demonstrate the ability to use an atlas, or online maps, to locate on a map the European Countries participating in the First World War.

Materials

Atlas or online maps.

Key Fact

During the First World War the borders of some countries were different, and other countries which participated in the war no longer exist, or have changed their name.

Task

Find the countries in the list below and colour them in on the map.

Use one colour for the 'Allied Powers' who fought with Australia, and another for their opponents, who were called the 'Central Powers.'

The map shows the borders in 1914, when the war began.

Remember that as some countries no longer have the same borders, a modern map does not look exactly the same as the one below.
